

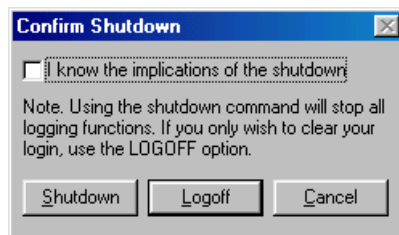
SHUTDOWN MENU

LOG OFF

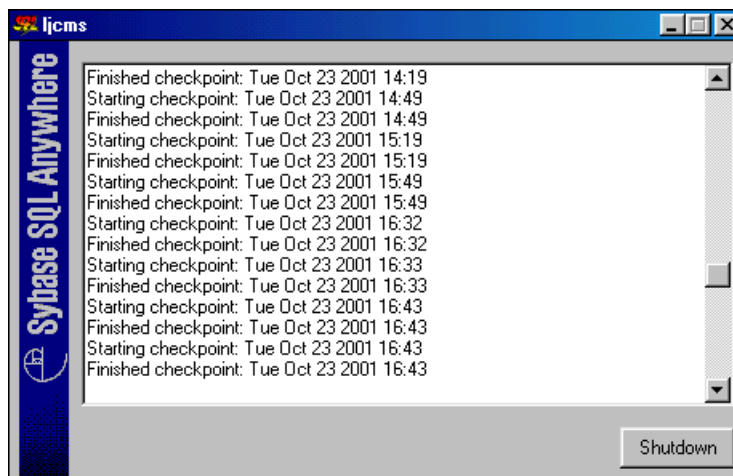
When you have finished your session on LUMBERJACK, log off so that the system cannot be used by an unauthorised person using your log-in. This will end the program on your PC. To re-establish your LUMBERJACK link, you will need to restart the program. This does not stop LUMBERJACK from logging.

SHUTDOWN

Shutdown closes LUMBERJACK and stops all logging. (If you have Fo-Net set up on your system it will buffer the call data until LUMBERJACK is started up again.) A warning box will appear asking if you know the implications of a Shutdown. If you really want to Shutdown, click in the check box and click on the Shutdown button.



Once a Shutdown has been requested, Lumberjack and Saw Mill will close but the SQL database engine will still be loaded on the server machine. This can only be closed from the server PC. To close, click on the Sybase icon and click on Shutdown.



ON NO ACCOUNT SHOULD THE DATABASE BE SHUT DOWN WHILST LUMBERJACK IS RUNNING
