



LJ BACKUPS

A network backup on the LJ server will not backup the LJ database as this is always open and in use.

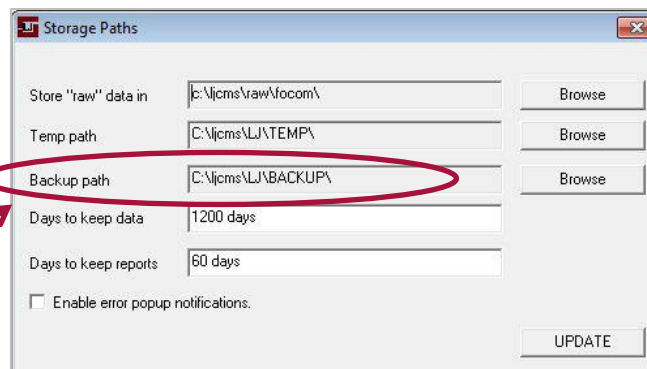
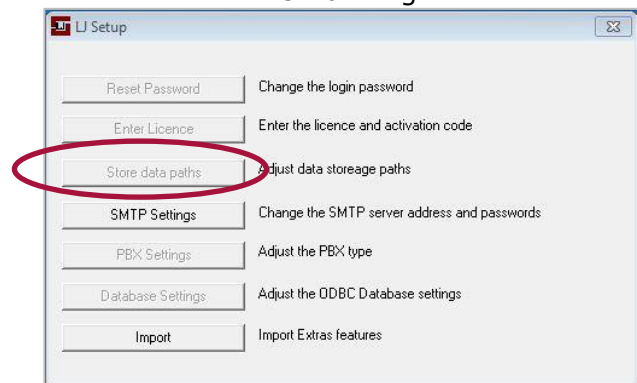
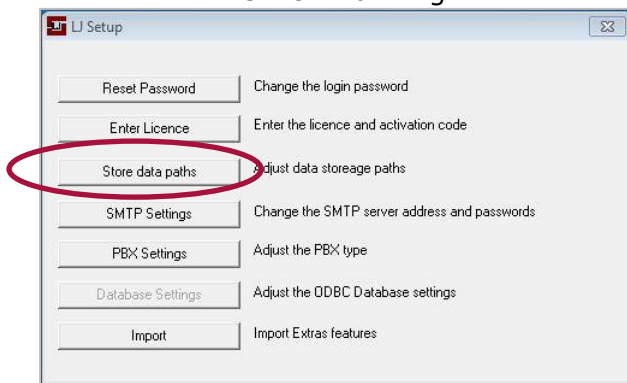
Backups (Daily, Weekly and Monthly) are a default part of the LJ program and these backups can then be backed-up by your standard network backup.

During installation you will have been asked to set the path for the backups.

Run **LJXSetup.exe**

This is the directory where your standard back-up will pick up the LJ Backups. Please note this path can only be changed while LJ is not running

There will be several **Daily** backups (Monday to Friday); each backs-up **Yesterday** and runs only once a week; the backup file is overwritten each time the backup runs.

There will be 4 **Weekly** backups; each backup runs on a Monday and backs-up the **Last 7 Days** – this effectively then frees up the Daily backups so that the files can be safely overwritten. Each Weekly backup runs every 28 days; the backup file is over written each time the backup runs.

There is only 1 **Monthly** backup which runs on the 1st of each month and is set to back up the **Last** (calendar) **Month**. The backup file does not overwrite the previous one. The file name is made unique by adding the date (when the backup runs) to the file name.
